Margherita Pace, soprano

She debuted in July 1991 at the Fermo Festival, and went on with performances at the Teatro Comunale of Piacenza, at the Vevey Theatre in Switzerland and at the Fondazione Umbria Spettacolo. She performed concert arias in Catania accompanied by the AMIT orchestra, and sang many times as a soloist in the Carmina Burana. She interpreted arias by Mozart in Rome and sang with the Jyvaskyla Sinfonia (Finlandia). From the chamber music repertoire she has performed Lieder by Mozart and Rossini, also in trio, with clarinet and flute. She performed and sang with Rossella Falk in an event produced by Teatro Eliseo. In 2007 she sang in an Opera Gala at the historic Asolo Theatre in Sarasota, Florida. She interpreted three roles at the Festival Internacional de Musica of Galicia, in Santiago de Compostela, produced by the Teatro La Fenice of Venice.

Luigi Petroni, tenore

Luigi Petroni made his professional debut at the Teatro Regio in Torino and this was followed by several engagements at the Teatro dell'Opera of Rome. He has been a regular guest of the Rossini Opera Festival of Pesaro, since his debut there in 1995. Other Italian engagements of the tenor have included performances at the Teatro Massimo Bellini of Catania, the Teatro La Fenice of Venice, the Teatro San Carlo of Napoli, the Teatro dell'Opera of Rome, the Teatro Comunale of Bologna, the Festival dei Due Mondi of Spoleto, as well as at the theatres of Trieste, Cagliari and Torino. He sang at the Teatro Lirico of Cagliari and made appearances at theatres in Milan, Montecarlo, Toulouse and the Opernhaus of Zurich.

Serena Marotti, piano

Having graduated from the Conservatory "S. Cecilia" and perfected her studies at the "Mozarteum" of Salzburg, she was recognized as a soloist at a very young age in concerts all over Europe. She is particularly concerned with chamber music and lieder in collaborations all around Italy. She has recorded for various radio broadcasts and television shows in Italy and abroad. She has collaborated with the Orchestra of the Teatro dell'Opera of Rome and as a soloist with the Symphonic Orchestra of Perugia. She has participated in the jury of international piano competitions and is a professor at the Music Conservatory of Perugia.
